



AAMN Foundation Announces \$500.⁰⁰ Jadeh Moore Essay Contest & Scholarship

The American Assembly for Men in Nursing Foundation is currently accepting essays from pre-licensure male or female students currently enrolled in an accredited school of nursing. The subject matter of the essay should focus on how the student arrived at the personal decision to enter the profession of nursing.

Scholarship Criteria

- Student Status: Pre-licensure male or female nursing student enrolled in an accredited school of nursing
- Essay length: No more than 500 words
- Formatting: MS Word documents only (No pdf or other formats will be accepted.)
Double-spaced
One-inch margin on all sides.
- Cover sheet: Title of the essay,
Name of student author,
Address,
Telephone number(s)
E-mail address
- Scholarliness: All essays must be completed independently as the student's own work and may not be edited.
Participants may use references.
APA format for all references.
- Evaluation Criteria: Essays will be judged on scholarly presentation, subject relevance, and creativity by a committee of the AAMN.

The author of the winning essay will be presented with an unrestricted \$500.00 award to apply toward his/her nursing education. The winning essay will be announced at the 34rd Annual Conference of the American Assembly for Men in Nursing entitled "*Men...Making a Difference in Nursing.*" The conference will convene October 23-24, 2009 in Cincinnati, Ohio.

Conference attendance is not required.

In addition, the winning essay and other suitable essays will be published in the *Interaction*, Official Publication of the American Assembly for Men in Nursing.
