

CALL FOR ABSTRACTS FOR 51st ANNUAL AAMN CONFERENCE

Abstract submissions are now being accepted for the 51st annual AAMN Conference, October 15-17 at the Horseshoe Las Vegas Resort.

The theme of this year's conference is, "Winning Hands: The Power of Nursing Innovations and Initiatives." The event objectives are as follows:

- Identify key concepts of workforce initiatives and explain how they contribute to effective nursing performance.
- Describe principles of cultural humility and effective communication within nursing.
- Demonstrate how to utilize the strengths within the nursing workforce to improve collaboration and patient outcomes.
- Identify evidence-based practices that promote the recruitment, retention, and support of diverse team members in clinical settings.
- Identify emerging nursing innovations—such as digital health tools, simulation training, and AI-supported workflows—and how they can enhance collaboration within nursing.

If you have a topic that would fit under one of these objectives, please submit your abstract by March 22. Please indicate whether you want to be considered for a podium presentation, poster presentation, or both.

Abstracts will be peer reviewed and selected participants will be notified roughly 45 days after the submission deadline. Remember, you must attend the conference and pay corresponding registration fees. Podium presenters are eligible for a discount of up to \$100 off the regular price of their registration fee (discount applies to attendees at the RN registration level).

Please include the following when submitting your abstract:

- Abstract title.
- Author name, credentials, and email address.
- A two or three paragraph abstract which includes a summary of the project, limitations/ conclusions, and implications for practice.
- A minimum of three references (must be current within the past five years).
